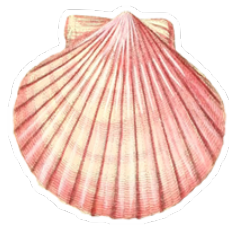
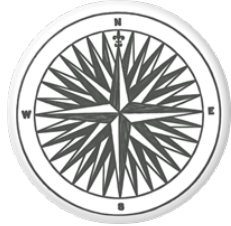
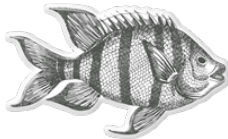

ad-ven-tur-ous (-dā, ō) [*ME. aventureus, aventure, OF. aventure, F. aventure*] Characterized by, or of the nature of, adventure; specific: a. inclined to adventure; willing to face hazard; prone to embark in hazardous enterprise; rashly daring; — applied to persons. *He was an adventurous boy.* *Bottom.* *Full of hazard, adorned with risk; exposing to danger; requiring courage; rash; — applied to acts; as, an adventurous undertaking, deed, song.*

para-dise (pā'rā-dīz), ō [*ME. & F. paradis, L. paradisus, fr. Gr. παράδεισος park, paradise, fr. Avestan paradisā an inclosure; pairs around (akin to Gr. περί) + dō to throw up, pile up, etc. Skt. dāt to amow, and E. dapple, Cf. parvis.]* *1.* [orig.] The garden of Eden, in which Adam and Eve were first placed. *Gen. ii. 8.* *2. a.* The abode of sanctified souls after death; either heaven, or, as some hold, an intermediate elysium for the souls of the righteous during the interval between death and final judgment. *Tuesday shall thou be with me in paradise. 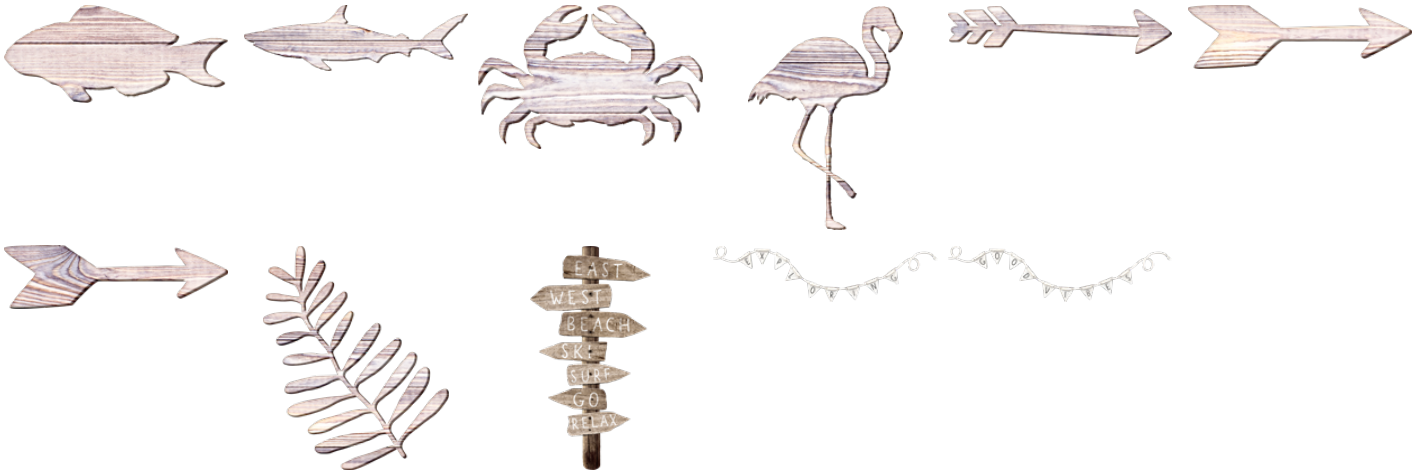
